

RECURVE

Meaning: To recurve means to bend or shape something, such as a bow or edges, into a curved form for improved functionality or aesthetic appeal.

1. The archery expert demonstrated how to recurve the bow for improved accuracy.
2. In the design phase, they decided to recurve the edges of the table for a smoother look.
3. The artist chose to recurve the lines of the sculpture to create a more dynamic shape.
4. To enhance the performance, the engineers opted to recurve the wing design of the aircraft.
5. As the story unfolded, the plot began to recurve, bringing back familiar themes and characters.
