

RECUSE

Meaning: To recuse means to withdraw from participation in a legal case or decision due to a potential conflict of interest or bias.

1. The judge had to recuse herself from the case due to a conflict of interest.
2. In order to ensure a fair trial, the attorney decided to recuse himself from representing the defendant.
3. After reviewing the evidence, the ethics committee recommended that he recuse from the investigation.
4. To maintain impartiality, the board chair chose to recuse himself during the vote on the proposal.
5. It is essential for public officials to recuse themselves when they have a personal stake in the outcome.
