

# REDACT

*Meaning: To redact means to edit or prepare a document for publication by removing or obscuring sensitive or confidential information.*

1. The editor had to redact sensitive information before publishing the report.
2. In order to protect the identities of the witnesses, the attorney decided to redact their names from the document.
3. During the security review, several passages were redacted to prevent the release of classified information.
4. The publisher will redact any material that could potentially harm individuals involved in the case.
5. She was shocked to find that her personal notes had been partially redacted in the final version of the manuscript.
