

REDHIBITION

Meaning: Redhibition is the legal right of a buyer to cancel a sale and seek a refund due to the discovery of hidden defects in a purchased item.

1. The concept of redhibition allows a buyer to seek a refund if a purchased item is found to have hidden defects.
2. In Louisiana law, redhibition refers to the right of a buyer to rescind a sale due to a significant defect in the product.
3. After discovering the car had serious engine problems, she decided to file for redhibition to reclaim her money.
4. The seller was unaware of the defect, but the buyer successfully claimed redhibition based on the misleading condition of the item.
5. Redhibition provides a legal remedy for consumers who unknowingly purchase goods that do not meet the agreed-upon standards.

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
