Meaning: Redisburse: to distribute or allocate funds again, typically to ensure equitable support or improved financial management.

1. The committee decided to redisburse the funds to ensure that all projects received adequate support.
2. After reviewing the budget, the finance team agreed to redisburse the allocations for improved efficiency.
3. To address the unexpected expenses, the organization needed to redisburse the existing grants effectively.
