

REDSHANK

Meaning: Redshank: a wading bird of the sandpiper family, characterized by long legs and a distinctive red or orange coloration on its legs and underparts.

1. The redshank wades through the shallow waters looking for small fish and invertebrates.
2. During our birdwatching trip, we spotted a redshank elegantly perched on a rock.
3. Redshanks are often identified by their long legs and distinctive reddish plumage during the breeding season.
4. The conservation team is working to protect the redshank's natural habitat from encroachment.
5. As the tide receded, the redshank moved closer to the shore, searching for its next meal.

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
