2. Her explanation was so thorough that the follow-up questions felt completely redundant.
3. Many employees were worried that automation would make their roles redundant in the near future.
4. The software update included several redundant features that only added confusion for users.
5. In the interest of efficiency, the manager decided to eliminate redundant tasks from the workflow.
