Meaning: REDUNDANTLY: in a manner that is unnecessarily repetitive or superfluous, often leading to confusion or inefficiency.

1. The instructions were explained redundantly, leaving the students feeling overwhelmed.
2. He repeated his point redundantly, making the meeting last longer than necessary.
3. The software included redundant features that confused users rather than helping them.
4. She redundantly emphasized her main argument, which detracted from its original impact.
5. Their plans were redundantly detailed in multiple documents, causing confusion among team members.
