

# REEFING

*Meaning: Reefing is the process of reducing the area of a sail by folding or rolling part of it to maintain control and reduce the risk of damage in strong winds.*

1. Reefing the sails was essential to maintain control during the storm.

3. After reefing, the boat sailed smoothly even in the gusty winds.
