

REFASTEN

Meaning: To refasten means to secure or attach something again, such as a seatbelt or shingles, that has become loose or unfastened.

1. She had to refasten her seatbelt before the plane took off.
2. After the storm, he went outside to refasten the loose shingles on the roof.
3. The child asked his father to help him refasten the button on his jacket.
4. Before heading out for the hike, she realized she needed to refasten her shoelaces.
5. He decided to refasten the lid on the jar to keep the contents fresh.
