Meaning: Referable: capable of being related to or derived from a source or precedent.

2. In many cases, it is more referable to use primary sources rather than secondary interpretations.

4. The results of the study are referable to the methodology employed by the researchers.
5. Her insights on the matter are referable to her extensive background in environmental science.
