

REFRACTORILY

Meaning: In a manner that deflects or resists authority or questions, often through evasive or contrary behavior.

1. She answered the questions refractorily, deflecting the conversation away from her personal life.
2. The child behaved refractorily when asked to tidy up his room, insisting that it was already clean.
3. Despite his supervisor's requests, he approached the tasks refractorily, showing little willingness to cooperate.
4. During the meeting, her refractorily attitude made it difficult for the team to reach a consensus.
5. He refractorily resisted following the new guidelines, preferring to stick to his own methods.
