Meaning: Refusal: the act of declining to accept, agree to, or participate in something.

1. Her refusal to compromise during negotiations led to a stalemate.
2. The teacher was disappointed by the student's refusal to participate in the class discussion.
3. His refusal to accept help demonstrated a stubbornness that worried his friends.
4. After much deliberation, the committee issued a formal refusal to the proposal.
5. The artist's refusal to conform to mainstream trends earned her both criticism and admiration.
