

# REGALISM

*Meaning: Regalism is the doctrine that asserts the supremacy of the monarchy over religious authority and governance.*

1. Regalism often leads to a clash between church authority and state power.
2. The philosophy of regalism is rooted in the belief that the monarchy holds supreme authority over religious matters.
3. In historical debates, regalism was frequently juxtaposed with the principle of papal supremacy.
4. The rise of regalism in the 17th century marked a significant shift in the relationship between monarchs and the church.
5. Critics of regalism argue that it undermines the autonomy of religious institutions.
