Meaning: Reglet: a narrow groove or channel carved into a surface, typically used to create a clean edge or to fit materials together.

1. The artisan carefully carved a reglet into the wood to create a clean edge for the panel.
2. To ensure a perfect fit, she made sure each reglet was precisely measured and cut.
3. The architect included a decorative reglet along the ceiling to enhance the room's aesthetic.
4. In the model, the reglet served as a subtle transition between the wall and the molding.
