Meaning: Regraft (verb): to surgically attach or transplant tissue or skin from one area to another to promote healing or repair.

1. The surgeon decided to regraft the damaged tissue to ensure proper healing.

3. In horticulture, it's common to regraft a tree to improve its fruit quality.
