

REGURGITATE

Meaning: Regurgitate: to bring swallowed food back up to the mouth for feeding or to repeat information without original thought or understanding.

1. The bird began to regurgitate its food to feed its young.
2. During the presentation, he seemed to regurgitate information rather than offer original insights.
3. After the long run, she felt nauseous and had to regurgitate her breakfast.
4. The student was able to regurgitate facts for the test but struggled to understand the concepts.
5. Some species of snakes regurgitate their prey when threatened by predators.
6. The bird will regurgitate food to feed its young.
7. After the intense debate, he began to regurgitate the arguments he had heard.
8. The doctor explained that the patient might regurgitate if he moved too soon after eating.
9. In the documentary, the whale was shown to regurgitate its prey to attract mates.
10. Some reptiles regurgitate their meals to aid in digestion or avoid predation.
