

REIMPOSE

Meaning: To reimpose means to establish or enforce something again, such as rules or restrictions, after they have been lifted or suspended.

1. The government decided to reimpose the travel restrictions after a surge in COVID-19 cases.
2. After careful consideration, the committee chose to reimpose the penalties for late submissions.
3. Local authorities may reimpose the curfew if the crime rates continue to rise.
4. In response to public outcry, the school board voted to reimpose the dress code policy.
5. Economists warned that the central bank might need to reimpose interest rate hikes to combat inflation.

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
