

REIMPRISONMENT

Meaning: Reimprisonment is the act of incarcerating someone again after they have previously been released from prison.

1. The judge's decision led to the reimprisonment of the defendant after new evidence emerged.
2. Reimprisonment can often feel like a betrayal to those who believed in the possibility of rehabilitation.
3. Advocates argue that reimprisonment should be a last resort, focusing instead on restorative justice.
