3. To celebrate its 50th anniversary, the organization planned to reinaugurate the community center with a festive event.
4. The governor was present to reinaugurate the newly restored bridge, highlighting its importance to local infrastructure.
5. As part of the revitalization project, the town will reinaugurate the old park with new facilities and landscaping.
