Meaning: To incur again or anew, typically referring to expenses or problems that reappear or are repeated.

1. The company had to reincur expenses after the unexpected failure of the machinery.
2. If we do not address the root cause, we may reincur the same issues next quarter.
3. After reviewing the project, the team decided to reincur some costs to ensure its success.
4. The board was cautious about any decision that might lead them to reincur previous losses.
5. In order to improve customer satisfaction, they may need to reincur some marketing expenses.
