Meaning: Reinspect: to examine or assess something again, typically to verify compliance or resolve previously identified issues.

1. The inspector decided to reinspect the building after receiving numerous complaints from the tenants.
2. After the initial failed inspection, the contractor was eager to reinspect the work to address the issues raised.
3. To ensure compliance with safety standards, the team will reinspect the equipment before it is put back into operation.
4. The quality control manager instructed the staff to reinspect all products that had been flagged during the previous audit.
5. Following the repairs, the regulatory agency scheduled a date to reinspect the facility for compliance.
