Meaning: Reinstate: to restore someone or something to a previous position, status, or condition.

1. The committee decided to reinstate the policy after reviewing its positive impact.
2. After a thorough investigation, the company chose to reinstate the employee who had been wrongfully terminated.
3. The government promised to reinstate funding for the community programs that had been cut last year.
4. To ensure fairness, they aimed to reinstate the original terms of the contract before the dispute arose.
5. Following public outcry, the school board voted to reinstate the popular music program.
