

REINTERROGATE

Meaning: Reinterrogate: to question someone again, especially to clarify or obtain additional information following new evidence or inconsistencies.

1. The detective decided to reinterrogate the key witness after discovering new evidence.
2. In light of the inconsistencies in his statement, the police opted to reinterrogate the suspect.
3. The committee agreed to reinterrogate the witnesses to ensure that all testimonies were consistent.
4. After reviewing the case file, the attorney felt it necessary to reinterrogate her client for clarification.
5. The investigative team planned to reinterrogate the informant to gather more detailed information.
