Meaning: Reiter (verb): To say or state something again, often for emphasis or clarity.

1. The artist decided to reiterate his message to ensure it was understood by everyone.
2. In her speech, the mayor chose to reiterate the importance of community involvement.
3. To avoid confusion, the teacher would often reiterate the key points of the lesson.
4. The scientist had to reiterate his findings multiple times before the public grasped their significance.
5. During the meeting, the manager felt the need to reiterate the company's goals for the upcoming year.
