

REJOURNMENT

Meaning: Rejournalment refers to the act of postponing or rescheduling a meeting, hearing, or session to a later time or date.

1. The judge announced a rejournalment to allow both parties more time to prepare their cases.
2. After a lengthy discussion, the committee decided on a rejournalment to address the new information presented.
3. The unexpected rejournalment left the audience in suspense, eagerly awaiting the new date for the hearing.
