*Meaning: RELAI: (verb) past tense of relay; to replace or reinstall something, such as tiles or pavement, in its proper position.*

2. After the storm damaged the road, the crew quickly relaid the asphalt to restore access.
3. The gardener decided to have the flower beds relaid to improve drainage and aesthetics.
4. The old carpet was removed and relaid to eliminate the unsightly stains.
5. To ensure better connectivity, the wiring was relaid throughout the entire building.
