

# RELICTION

*Meaning: Reliction is the gradual process by which land previously covered by water is exposed due to the receding of that water.*

1. The gradual process of reliction has revealed ancient artifacts along the shoreline.
2. Following the prolonged drought, the reliction of the lake exposed a long-forgotten village beneath the water.
3. Legal disputes often arise over property rights in cases of reliction, as boundaries shift with the changing landscape.
4. The scientists studied the reliction phenomenon to understand its impact on local ecosystems and biodiversity.
5. As the river receded, the reliction of land provided new opportunities for agriculture in the previously submerged areas.
