*Meaning: RELOAN (verb): To provide a new loan or to refinance an existing loan, often under different terms or conditions.*

1. Many borrowers choose to reloan their mortgages to take advantage of lower interest rates.

3. After reviewing his finances, he decided it was time to reloan his car to secure a better deal.
