

RELUCTIVITY

Meaning: Reluctivity refers to a reluctance or unwillingness to participate or engage in activities or discussions.

1. Reluctivity often surfaces in discussions about group dynamics and individual participation.
2. The scientist noted the reluctivity of subjects when asked to engage in the experiment.
3. In negotiations, a sense of reluctivity can hinder progress and create tension between parties.
4. Her reluctivity to share her ideas made it difficult for the team to move forward.
5. Understanding the factors contributing to reluctivity can improve collaboration in any setting.
