

REMANET

Meaning: REMANET: To send a case back to a lower court for further proceedings or to retain funds in a specified account until a matter is resolved.

1. The court decided to remanet the case for further investigation.
2. After the review, it was determined that the funds would remanet in the account until the issue was resolved.
3. The committee voted to remanet the decision until all members could contribute their opinions.
4. In her will, she specified that her estate would remanet in trust for her children's education.
5. The judge ordered the documents to remanet sealed until the trial concluded.
