

RENEGATION

Meaning: Renegation refers to the act of formally rejecting or abandoning a previously agreed-upon commitment or treaty.

1. The renegation of the treaty left both nations in a state of uncertainty.
2. Her abrupt renegation of the agreement shocked everyone involved in the negotiations.
3. The group's renegation of their previous commitments raised questions about their integrity.
4. After much deliberation, he decided that renegation was the only option left to protect his interests.
5. The consequences of such a renegation could affect future diplomatic relations significantly.

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
