Meaning: REPEALABLE: capable of being revoked or annulled by legislative action.

1. The controversial law is repealable if enough public support is mobilized against it.
2. Many activists are campaigning for a repealable amendment that limits voting rights.
3. In some jurisdictions, certain regulations are considered repealable after a specified period.
4. The repealable nature of the policy allows for adjustments as societal needs change.
5. Lawmakers debated whether the new tax could be made repealable in future sessions.
