*Meaning: Reperusal refers to the act of reviewing or examining something again, particularly a document or written material.*

1. The reperusal of the document revealed several overlooked errors.
2. During the meeting, a reperusal of the previous minutes helped clarify many points.
3. Her decision to conduct a reperusal of the evidence swayed the jury's opinion.
4. The reperusal of classic literature often leads to new interpretations and insights.
5. After a thorough reperusal, he felt more confident in his argument for the debate.
