

# REPLEADER

*Meaning: Repleader is a legal document submitted to clarify or amend the claims or allegations made in an initial complaint or pleading.*

1. The attorney submitted a repleader to clarify the claims made in the initial complaint.
2. In complex litigation, a repleader may be necessary to address ambiguities in the original pleadings.
3. After reviewing the evidence, the judge encouraged the plaintiff to file a repleader to strengthen their case.

5. Defendants often request a repleader when they believe the initial allegations are too vague to respond to adequately.

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
