

# REPONE

*Meaning: Repon (verb): to postpone or defer a legal case or discussion to a later time for further consideration or evidence.*

1. The judge decided to repon the case for further evidence.
2. After reviewing the documents, she asked to repon the discussion until next week.
3. They were able to repon the meeting to accommodate everyone's schedule.
4. The committee voted to repon the vote until all members could be present.
5. He requested to repon his application, hoping for a better outcome.
