Meaning: REPOSSESS: To take back property that was previously given to someone, typically due to failure to make required payments or fulfill contractual obligations.

1. The bank had to repossess the car when the owner failed to make the payments.
2. After several warnings, the landlord decided to repossess the apartment due to unpaid rent.
3. She was devastated when the lender came to repossess her home after the financial crisis.
4. In an effort to recover losses, the company chose to repossess the equipment it had leased to the business.
5. The process to repossess a vehicle can be complicated and often requires legal assistance.
