Meaning: Reprehensory: expressing disapproval or criticism, often in a harsh or severe manner.

1. The teacher provided a reprehensory critique of the student's careless mistakes.
2. His reprehensory remarks during the meeting caused tension among the team members.
3. She felt his reprehensory gaze upon her as she made the mistake.
4. The film faced reprehensory reviews for its lack of originality and poor storytelling.
5. In a reprehensory tone, he addressed the unethical practices observed in the company.
