Meaning: Repressor: a molecule or entity that inhibits or suppresses a specific biological process or expression, such as gene activity or dissent.

1. The repressor protein binds to the operator site to inhibit gene expression.

3. The repressor's role in the regulatory network is crucial for maintaining cellular homeostasis.
