

REPRIEVAL

Meaning: Reprieval refers to a temporary relief or postponement of a punishment or sentence.

1. The lawyer argued for a reprieval of the harsh sentence given to his client.
2. After much deliberation, the committee decided to grant a reprieval for the student's suspension.
3. The governor announced a temporary reprieval for those on death row while new evidence was reviewed.
4. In hopes of a reprieval, the activists rallied to raise awareness about the unjust policies.
5. A reprieval was issued to allow the farm additional time to comply with new environmental regulations.
