Meaning: To reprove means to scold or criticize someone gently for a fault or mistake.

1. She decided to reproach her colleague for his careless mistakes during the presentation.
2. The teacher chose to reprove the students gently, reminding them of the importance of honesty.
3. After noticing the oversight, he felt it necessary to reprove his assistant in private.
4. Though he wanted to reprove her for missing the deadline, he understood the circumstances behind it.
5. His parents would often reprove him for leaving his toys scattered across the living room.
