Meaning: Reprover: a person who corrects or criticizes someone for their mistakes or misbehavior.

1. The teacher acted as a reprover, gently correcting the students' misunderstandings.
2. As a reprover of bad behavior, she made it clear that honesty was a non-negotiable value.
3. His role as a reprover often put him at odds with his friends, who preferred a more lenient approach.
4. The reprover's words lingered in her mind, prompting her to rethink her decisions.
5. In his capacity as a reprover, he emphasized the importance of accountability among his peers.
