

REPUBLICANIZE

Meaning: To republicanize means to modify or adapt policies, platforms, or governance to align with republican principles or ideologies, often in order to appeal to a wider audience or voter base.

1. The party aimed to republicanize its platform to attract a broader voter base.
2. In an effort to republicanize the state's policies, the governor proposed several reforms.
3. Activists sought to republicanize the education system, emphasizing traditional values.
