Meaning: Repulsory: causing a strong feeling of aversion or rejection; having the ability to repel or deter.

1. The repulsory nature of the substance made it nearly impossible to handle without protective gear.
2. Her repulsory behavior towards the idea of failure left her feeling isolated from her peers.
3. The film's repulsory imagery caused many viewers to leave the theater before it ended.
4. Insects are often deterred by repulsory chemicals that plants release to protect themselves.
5. His repulsory comments during the meeting alienated his colleagues and stifled collaboration.
