

REREBRACE

Meaning: Rerebrace: to reinforce or provide additional support to a structure that has previously been braced.

1. The architect decided to rerebrace the structure after noticing the initial supports were insufficient.
2. To ensure safety, the engineers agreed it was necessary to rerebrace the aging bridge.
3. After the storm, the construction team was called in to rerebrace the weakened walls of the building.
