Meaning: To rescind means to revoke, cancel, or annul a decision, offer, or policy.

1. The company decided to rescind the offer after discovering discrepancies in the candidate's resume.
2. After a thorough review, the board voted to rescind the new policy due to public backlash.
3. The judge ruled to rescind the previous verdict, allowing for a retrial in the case.
4. She felt relieved when the landlord agreed to rescind the eviction notice.
5. The school administration plans to rescind the mandatory attendance policy for remote learners.
