

RESCISSORY

Meaning: Rescissory refers to an action or order that annuls or cancels a legal contract or agreement, typically due to issues such as fraud or misrepresentation.

1. The court issued a rescissory order to annul the contract due to fraudulent misrepresentation.
2. In legal disputes, a rescissory action can provide relief to parties harmed by a previous agreement.
3. Her attorney filed a rescissory motion to challenge the enforceability of the settlement.
4. The rescissory clause in the contract allowed either party to withdraw under specific conditions.
5. After reviewing the evidence, the judge found sufficient grounds for a rescissory judgment.

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
