

RESECTION

Meaning: Resection is the surgical removal of a portion of an organ or tissue, often to excise a tumor or diseased area.

1. Resection of the tumor was necessary to prevent the cancer from spreading further.
2. After the resection, the patient required extensive rehabilitation to regain strength.
3. The surgeon explained that a partial resection of the organ could improve the patient's quality of life.
