

RESEIZURE

Meaning: Reseizure refers to the act of taking possession of evidence or property again, typically following a legal ruling or due to procedural errors in the initial seizure.

1. The court ordered a reseizure of the evidence due to improper handling during the initial search.
2. After the suspect's appeal, the judge approved a reseizure of the property in question.
3. The police conducted a reseizure of the assets following new information regarding their ownership.
4. In cases of disputed ownership, a reseizure may be necessary to clarify legal rights.
5. The attorney filed a motion for a reseizure to protect the interests of her client.
