Meaning: Resplit (verb): to divide or partition data or results again to enhance accuracy or accommodate new information.

1. The technician decided to resplit the data set to improve the accuracy of the analysis.

3. After reviewing the project, she recommended that we resplit the team's tasks for better efficiency.
